

JUBILEE FUND SEEKS GROWTH TO MEET THE NEED

As 2023 comes to an end, we celebrate the work Jubilee Fund has been able to do and pause to consider how much more has been left undone.

This is the typical circumstance of the average non-profit working to reduce and ultimately end poverty. The challenges seem nearly insurmountable but the successes continue to provide energy and impetus to see the work continue.

Thanks to the generosity of donors and impact investors, Jubilee Fund has been able to support several large projects in the housing, food services and affordable daycare sectors with \$690,000.00 in lending assistance.

"The work that Jubilee Fund has accomplished in 2023 is of a magnitude of order larger than previous years," said Chair Darryl Loewen. "Everything being done is directly impacting poverty by helping to create new housing units, transitional housing units, affordable daycare spaces and access to food services and employment."

Above and beyond these things Jubilee Fund's Rent Guarantee Program has broadened beyond the initial demographic of at-risk women to include previously incarcerated, newcomers, youth aging out of care and the disabled. The program has successfully supported the safe and affordable housing of numerous families and we have already begun to see applicants successfully graduate from the initiative moving on to self-sustainable housing.

With these successes have come increased awareness in Jubilee Fund and the supports we provide. As awareness increases the number of needs, we become aware of grow as well and thus the need for additional funds to continue to meet these and future needs.

"Our assets are close to being entirely leveraged," said Finance Committee Chair Nico Velthuys. "We cannot utilize more than 90 percent of the assets we manage for loans and loan/rent guarantees which means to continue to grow and do the work we are doing is going to require additional donations and investment." One of the key areas of need in Manitoba (and across Canada) has been affordable housing. In order to have an impact in this area requires a significant growth in Jubilee Fund assets as some of the projects in this area are millions, and even tens of millions of dollars.

Jubilee Fund is working hard to enlist new investment partners and communicate the need so that we can go into 2024 ready to continue to tackle the ever growing and substantial threat of poverty in Winnipeg and throughout Manitoba.

We appreciate the trust our donors and investors have placed in us and our hope is that it will not only continue but also grow to help meet the need. It can grow in many ways – via donations and investments from current donors and impact investors as well as new ones.

As 2023 comes to an end please consider continuing your support, growing it if you can and recommending Jubilee Fund to like minded friends seeking to see an impact with the investment in social finance.
