

# STABILITY, VISIBILITY AND GROWTH - THIS IS JUBILEE FUND'S 2022

What a year 2022 has been for Jubilee Fund. It has been a whirlwind and, in many ways, has flown by faster than we could imagine.

We are thankful for increased stability, visibility and growth over the past year and for this, we owe a debt of gratitude to our investors and donors, our staff and volunteers, and our partners.

In the past 12 months, we have seen our project support develop to such a degree that almost 90 percent of the assets entrusted to us are leveraged against some amazing projects that are geared toward poverty reduction.

This gives us the kind of problem we want to have – in order to continue to grow and serve Manitoba through supporting poverty reduction initiatives we will need to grow our investment and donor base (which has already grown substantially in the past year).

If there was a theme in 2022, it would have to be housing – safe, affordable, accessible housing has skyrocketed to the top of the list. Research has shown that housing, more than any other amenity, has the greatest positive impact on a person's life in terms of reducing and eliminating the risks of things like addiction, as well as providing the foundation for good mental and physical well-being.

Jubilee Fund is supporting The Rainbow Resource Centre's redevelopment of a new location that will include Manitoba's first affordable housing project for seniors who are part of the 2SLGBTQ+community.

We provided a loan guarantee in partnership with Assiniboine Credit Union to Raising the Roof's Reside initiative – a project that sees the redevelopment of an infill property in Winnipeg's core into a safe, secure three-apartment complex for families, and youth transitioning out of care.

As part of the Reside project. Jubilee Fund partner Purpose Construction is taking the lead on the renovations. 2022 also saw Jubilee extend a loan guarantee to Purpose Construction so that they could create a new siding and eaves trough division allowing them to offer further skills training and employment to those who would otherwise struggle to secure sound employment.

Of course, we cannot talk about 2022 without mentioning our most exciting and ambitious project – the Rent Guarantee Program (RGP) for at-risk women. This pilot project, which launched in May, was the brainchild of Jubilee Fund's Fund Development Manager Monica Sigurdson who proposed we take our loan guarantee model and apply it to individuals.

Specifically, the RGP sees Jubilee Fund leverage funds to guarantee one full year of rent for women seeking safe, affordable housing. Women leaving circumstances of abuse often do not have the benefit of a publicly available financial history to show when applying for housing. This leaves them scrambling to secure less than ideal housing, sometimes under the auspices of predatory property owners. In the worst cases, women have gone back into abusive circumstances feeling they have no other choice.

The RGP has seen over 80 inquiries resulting in around 20 individuals housed to date. The RGP pilot project has succeeded beyond our wildest expectations and is having an incredibly positive impact on the lives of women and children! It is our intent and hope to continue to grow our investment and donor base to ensure the program continues and expands to other demographics including youth-coming-out-of-care, previously incarcerated community members and newcomers/immigrants.

This past year also saw us create a new fund at The Winnipeg Foundation. This fund will grow visibility of Jubilee Fund to a new and large demographic of prospective donors and investors while creating a new revenue stream for the long-term sustainability of our organization. Funds with the Winnipeg Foundation pay interest back to the holder forever (or as long as the more than century old foundation continues to exist)

Whew! As you can see, it has been a heck of a year. All of this during a time when we have been without office space due to a lengthy relocation and renovation process. Thankfully, we were finally able to move into our new space on November 1st.

These are just the highlights of an incredible year. Thank you for standing with us and the worthy people and projects we have been able to support. Without you, none of this would have been possible.

Now here is to next year and our continued ability to grow and do more for Manitobans.
