



### **South Sudanese Community Centre - Emergency Loan in Response to Covid-19**

The Jubilee Fund is pleased to provide an emergency loan to South Sudanese Community Centre.

The current health crisis hit the South Sudanese Community Centre hard. Hall rentals represent a significant portion of their monthly revenue. With health orders in place; they were forced to close the hall indefinitely on March 21, 2020.

As with many other non-profit organizations, the Community Centre is run entirely on volunteer labour making it ineligible for Federal emergency wage subsidy programs. For several years the Community Centre has been renovating the hall, classrooms, childcare centre and rental office space. They also just installed an elevator in the building making it accessible for all. Elevator use has stopped but the bills did not.

The Jubilee Fund is pleased to support South Sudanese Community Centre with an emergency loan of \$5,000 to help offset monthly fixed costs. The hard work and dedication that has gone into creating this Community Centre, will no doubt flourish when we can all come together again; in the meantime, we want to help.
